

SJRC Directions to all Venues

Cooper River Boathouse

From Rt 38

- Go west toward Camden
- Take the Cuthbert Blvd. South exit (toward Collingswood and Oaklyn)
- Stay on Cuthbert Blvd. South for 0.7 miles
- Turn right at the 1st traffic light onto North Park Drive
- The boathouse is located on the left
- Park in the lot or anywhere along the street

From Rt. 70

- Go west to Cuthbert Blvd and take the exit for Collingswood
- Turn right at the 1st traffic light onto North Park Drive
- The boathouse is located on the left
- Park in the lot or anywhere along the street

Schuykill Race Course

- Take the Ben Franklin Bridge to Rt 676 Follow to Rt 76 West (Schuykill Expressway)
- Take the Lincoln Drive exit; cross over the river, get in the left hand lane (road curves around to the left); follow sign for Kelly Drive
- Follow Kelly Drive straight through two traffic lights. Stay in right hand lane. There will most likely be a police roadblock allowing only those who have parking permits through to the racing area on Kelly Drive. Make sure your pass is visible.
- St. Joe's Boathouse and Canoe Club (where boat trailers are parked) will be on the right hand side. No parking is allowed in this lot except for equipment vehicles. Parents can drop kids off here to find our trailer. Drivers can continue up Kelly Drive for parking.
- Traffic is one way and right side of road is used for angled parking. There are parking lots farther down the course.

WYRA Boathouse, Wilmington, Delaware (Estimate drive 30-40 minutes)

- Follow Interstate 95 South into Wilmington, Delaware
- Take Martin Luther King Blvd Exit 6
- Follow ramp and make left onto Martin Luther King Blvd
- Stay to the right
- Pass the train station (on the right)
- Go 1 ½ blocks and make a right on Poplar (just under the overpass). Park in any lot.
- WYRA Wilmington Youth Rowing Association boathouse will be on the left.

Mercer County Park

From South Via Interstate 295

- Take Interstate 295 North to exit 65 A, Sloan Avenue
- Go East on Sloan Avenue to 1st traffic light
- Go straight through intersection onto Flock Road and travel 0.7 miles to Paxson Avenue
- Turn left onto Paxson and go 0.9 mile to intersection of Hughes Drive and entrance to the park

From South Via NJ Turnpike

- Take Turnpike to Exit 7A
- Follow west on I-195 to exit 5B (first exit on 195)
- Travel North on Route 130 to 1st light (Rt. 526)
- Turn left at light and right at next light (still Rt. 526)
- From this point travel 3 miles to Rt. 535 (Edinburgh Rd.)
- Turn left on 535 and travel 0.2 miles to entrance of Mercer County Park on right

Upper Merion Boat Club

From the junction of the PA Turnpike (I-276) the Schuylkill Expressway (I -76) and Route 202 in King of Prussia

- Proceed North on 202 to Business 202 (DeKalb St. Bridgeport)
- Bear left at the first light (staying on DeKalb) and go straight through the next light (junction with Route 23)
- At the next light, turn left into the parking lot
- The boathouse is about 300 yards along the river

From I-95 North

- Take the Blue Route (I-476) North to the Conshohocken Route 23 exit
- Go west on Route 23, following it to the junction with DeKalb Street
- Turn right on DeKalb Street
- At the next light, turn left into the parking lot
- The boathouse is about 300 yards along the river

From the Schuylkill Expressway (I-76) East or West

- Take the Conshohocken Route 23 exit
- Go west on Route 23, following it to the junction with DeKalb Street / Rout 202
- Turn right on DeKalb Street
- Make a left at the first light into the parking lot
- The boathouse is about 300 yards along the river

Long Island Championships : Oyster Bay, Long Island

Special Note: There is a low bridge in Oyster Bay with a clearance of 10 ft. 1 in. If you follow the quickest route to Centre Island you may be directed to go under this bridge. If you have a trailer or bus with more than 10 ft 1 in vertical height please use the alternative directions listed below. It does pay to measure your trailer height for safety and convenience.

Directions to Centre Island Beach: From I-495 the Long Island Expressway (L.I.E.)

- 24 minutes from Expressway
- At exit 41N of the Expressway - Take 106 / 107 north for 1/2 mile and stay to the right for Route 106. Continue for 6 miles on 106.
- Turn left onto Lexington Avenue. (There is a Hess gas station on your left at this corner.)
- Go for 1/2 mile to the end.
- Turn left onto West Main Street. Go through two traffic lights and the road curves to the right.
- After the railroad underpass (Height 10' 1") the street name will change to West Shore Road.
- Continue for 2 miles to the Bayville Drawbridge.
- Cross the bridge and make the first right. Go for 1 mile to the end.
- Turn right onto Bayville Ave. Go a short ways.
- Finally turn right into the Centre Island Beach Park.

Alternate Directions that Avoid the Low Railroad Underpass: From I-495

- 35 minutes from the expressway
- At exit 41N of the Expressway - Take 106 / 107 north for 1/2 mile and stay to the right for Route 106. Continue on 106 for 3.5 miles.
- Turn left at RT-25A W (Northern Blvd). Go 2.2 miles.
- Turn right at Wolver Hollow Rd. Go .6 miles.
- Turn left at Piping Rock Rd. Go to the end 3 miles. The road comes to a fork at the end.
- Bear left at the fork onto Birch Hill Rd. Go a short ways and cross the railroad tracks.
- Immediately turn right onto Buckram Rd. (Forest Ave/ Buckram). Go 1 mile.
- Turn left onto Bayville Rd. Go 2.2 miles. You will see the Long Island Sound as you curve right.
- Continue onto Bayville Ave. (Same road you are on). Go 2.5 miles.
- Turn right into Centre Island Beach Park

Parking at Centre Island

All Trailers and Buses will use the West half of the lot. Buses park to the North and Trailers park to the South. Cars will use the East half of the lot. Avoid parking next to curbs or blocking traffic flow. Feel free to park next to the curb to unload your tents. After unloading please leave the curbsides open for emergency vehicles.

Northeast/Mid-Atlantic Championships : Quinsigamond State Park, Worcester, Mass.

From the East or Northeast: Take Rte. 495 to Rte. 290 West, follow 290 West until exit 22 (Main St. Shrewsbury); take a right at the bottom of the ramp, then through the lights take the fourth left onto North Lake Ave. Proceed south 1.4 miles; UMASS power plant and Hospital is on right, park entrance is on the left: watch for a break in the median strip.

From the East or West on the Mass Turnpike: Take the Millbury exit off the Mass Pike (Rte. I-90), turn left at the bottom of the ramp onto Rte. 122 North (Grafton St.) until the third set of lights. Take a right onto Sunderland Rd. to the next set of lights; then take a left on Lake Ave. Proceed 2.3 miles, cross Rte 9; park entrance is on the right.

From the West: Traveling Rte 290: Proceed East on Rte 290 to the Plantation St exit, take a right at the bottom of the ramp then take a left onto Natural History Rd, Natural History Road then becomes North Lake Ave within 300 feet proceed South 1 mile Park entrance is on the left, (watch for a break in the median strip. UMASS power plant and Hospital is on right.)

From East or West on Rte. 9: From the east take Rte. 9 West until you cross Lake Quinsigamond; take first right onto Lake Ave North. Park entrance is on right. From the east take Rte. 9 East until last set of lights before crossing Lake Quinsigamond; take a left at this set of lights onto Lake Ave North. Park entrance is on right.

Lake Park: from the Regatta Point entrance travel south on Lake Ave., crossing Rte. 9, for 1.1 miles to the Lake Park entrance. The entrance is on the left hand side (the first left in divided road after Worcester Rink).
